### Key Events & Themes of Ruth

Boaz is the family's "kinsman-\_\_\_\_\_", someone — usually the nearest relative — charged with vindicating justice either by \_\_\_\_\_ family property taken or sold under constraint, or by avenging the unlawful slaying of a family member. (Leviticus 25:25-26, Numbers 35)
