## Key Themes of Amos & Application

1. God's justice applies to \_\_\_\_\_ people.
  - A. The "Day of the Lord" will bring God's justice on \_\_\_\_\_ people ... including His \_\_\_\_\_ people! (5:18-20)  
Application: Prosperity is not necessarily an indication of God's \_\_\_\_\_.  
Application: Difficult circumstances are not necessarily an indication of God's \_\_\_\_\_.  
Application: Examine yourself; make sure your \_\_\_\_\_ is right before God.

- B. Because of their relationship with God, God's people will be held \_\_\_\_\_ accountable than their neighbors.  
Application: Compare your \_\_\_\_\_ to God's Word and His calling on \_\_\_\_\_ life, not to others.

Application: Develop an \_\_\_\_\_ devotion to God.
3. A faithful \_\_\_\_\_ will be preserved and will someday see a day of glorious restoration and blessing. (9:11-15)  
Application: Be encouraged! God will ultimately work \_\_\_\_\_ out for good. (Romans 8:28)
4. God uses who He \_\_\_\_\_ to do His work. (1:1; 7:14-15)  
Application: Don't limit \_\_\_\_\_ as to what God will do through \_\_\_\_\_!
