- A. He will be another "Helper" (14:16, 26)
 - Paraklete helper, advocate, comforter, counselor, encourager one who is always there to give special care in times of need to stand with & stand up for
- B. He will be with them forever (14:16, 17)
- C. He will live in them (14:17)
- D. He is the Spirit of truth (14:17)
- E. He will teach them all things (14:26)
- F. He will help them remember Jesus' words (14:26)

5. The world's relationship to Jesus
